

# MOULIN BORDEAUX

*100 % Cabernet Sauvignon*



Moulin is an amazing South facing single vineyard located at the top altitude of Grand Verdus, overlooking the village with a view over 60 kilometers. Terroir is unique to this vineyard, with little pebble rocks (graves) laying on red and brown clay, with a hint of alios (iron concretion).

This is obviously the ideal soil conditions for Cabernet-Sauvignon, and it shows at each vintage a unique depth and velvety texture.

Besides some very few Grands Crus from Pauillac or Saint-Julien, this is one of the unique straight Cabernet-Sauvignon in Bordeaux. Especially on the right bank where gravelly soils are pretty rare !

**Vinification :** manual harvest and concrete tank fermentation. Maceration of 18 days. Soft « fusion mode » of grapes maceration, with limited pump-overs. Pneumatic pressing.

**Ageing :** 12 months in 400 L barrels, 1 and 2 years-old.

**To drink** for 5 to 10 years, on grilled meat, vegetable gratin, or mature hard cheeses!

**Yield :** 38 hl/ha | **Production :** ~ 4 200 bottles

**Soil :** Gravels, red and brown clay, alios
